



Destiny Discover Websites

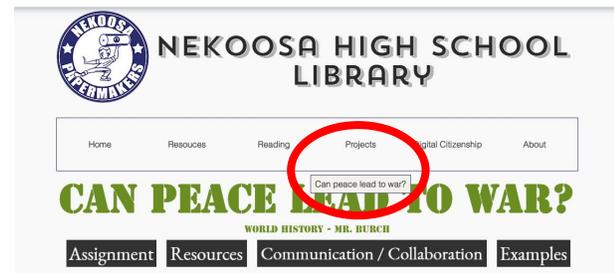
(formally WebPath Express)

Destiny Discover Websites is a database that allows students to search more than 105,000 trustworthy, relevant websites in one convenient search, while filtering out questionable and irrelevant content.

This document provides instructions on how to access and utilize this great research tool. Additionally the QR code to the right → will take you to a video walk through of how to use this tool as an alternative to this document.



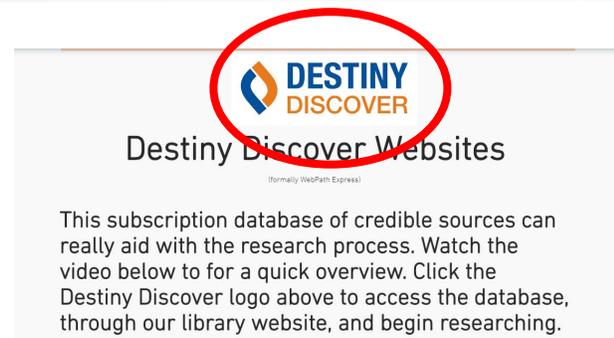
From the NHS library website navigate to “Projects” tab and hover over it until you see “Can peace lead to war?” and then click on that.



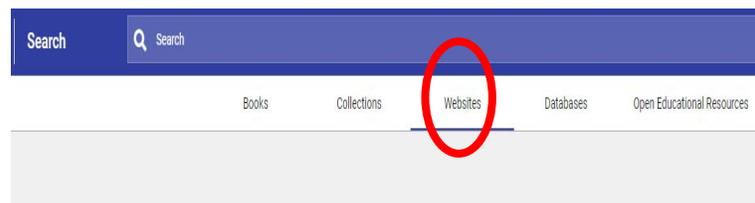
You should now find yourself on the main “Can Peace Lead to War?” page. From here click the “Resources” tab.



Scroll down the “Resources” page until you see the “Destiny Discover” picture. Click on this picture and you’ll be directed to Destiny Discovery Website via the library catalog.



Destiny Discover should open in a new tab (preselected to websites) which should look like the photo to the right.

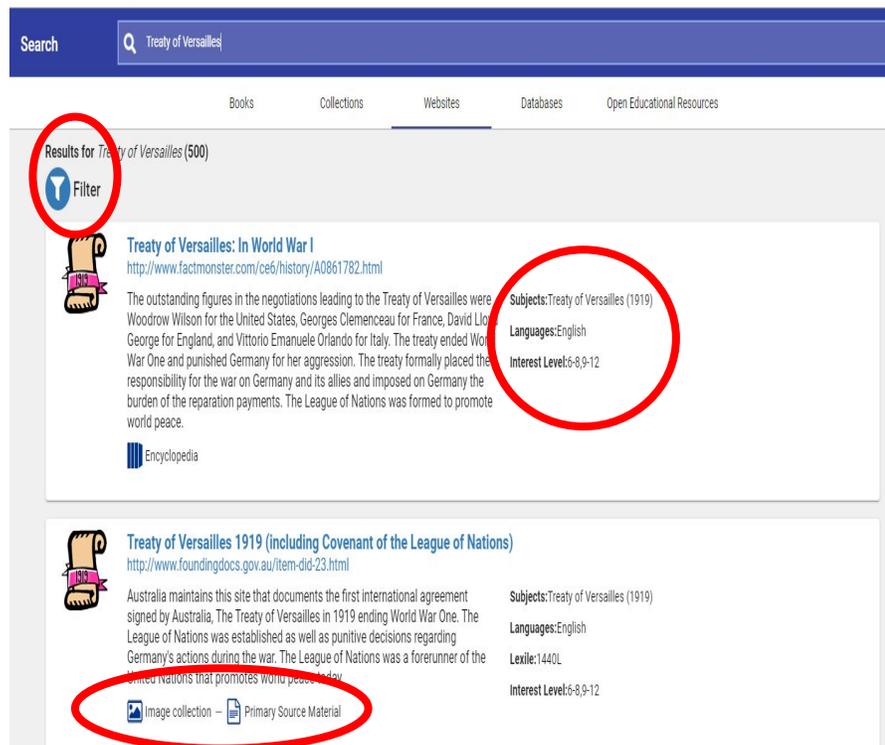


Type your keyword or subject in the search bar on top and hit enter. Search results will look similar to the photo on the right.

Notice to the right of the search result is displayed the subject, language and interest level.

Below the search result is where the source comes from or what it contains.

By clicking the “Filter” button, results can be sorted a number of ways. See below for some examples.



Results can be sorted by: Subject, Format, Source, Lexile, Language & Domain

1. The photo on the left shows how results can be filtered by source type (e.g. News Source, Map/Atlas, etc...).
2. The photo on the right shows how results can be filter by format type (e.g. Audio, Video, Image collection, etc..)
